Old Business

The Township's Planning Commission continues to review and revise the Student Housing Ordinance as part of the Zoning Code according to Commissioner Nagle.

New Business

Commissioner Nagle noted that the Township's budget has been approved with a 9% tax increase. Also being considered, is a charge of a \$100 fee for each college dormitory room which is considered a "rental unit". The Radnor Association of Township Employees union (R.A.T.E.) has agreed to a salary freeze and there will be three employees laid off. R.A.T.E. members will also contribute to the cost of their medical coverage. The budget for 2011 still has a short-fall in funds.

The Township has received \$500,000 from an insurance policy covering malfeasance .

The new fee schedule for 2011 will be voted on by the Board of Commissioners at their January meeting.

A new Police Chief has not been hired as of yet, but there are three weeks left until that decision has to be made.

There has been a suggestion that Radnor School District be moved into the Township's Municipal Building on Iven Avenue and the Senior Center and Radnor Memorial Library then be moved into the School District building on South Wayne Avenue next to the Middle School.
