

## **Minutes of the Bryn-Rose Civic Association Meeting of November 29, 2012**

The Bryn-Rose Civic Association met in the Radnor United Methodist Church, 930 Conestoga Road, Rosemont, Pennsylvania at 7:00 P.M. on the above date.

### **Minutes of October 25, 2012**

Bob Adams motioned to approve the minutes as written. Duly seconded, the minutes were approved.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Our account balance remains at \$373.22, which includes \$37. in petty cash.

### **Old Business**

Student Rental Housing remains a problem though out the neighborhoods. Parking is a big issue and the Parking Permit Application and enforcement should be looked at again by our Township officials. There should be very few exceptions or extra permits being issued. If there are too many cars at one location, there is a reason.

### **New Business**

A large outdoor party was held at a student rental in the 800 block of Conestoga Road in Rosemont, on November 11, 2012 to which the police responded three times. The students were cited when Superintendent Colarulo showed up after the forth call.

There are too many tenants in a number of Garrett Avenue students rentals and cars parked on the P&W bridge where it is not permitted. as proposed. It is felt that the students come and go, but it's the landlords who remain constant, know the rental housing laws in Radnor and choose to ignore them. If the landlords were fined, it could be a way to get their attention.

Commissioner John Nagle of the 5<sup>th</sup> Ward sent a-mail tell us of his meeting with Father Donohue, President of Villanova University, to share how unhappy we continue to be with his student's bad behavior, the perception is that VU doesn't care and there are no consequences for the students. He mentioned that Father Slack and Paul Pugh meet with the community and he expressed the opinion that the feeling is that that is just lip service and nothing changes as a result. The Villanovian (VU newspaper) had reported 12 incidents from underage drinking, theft, intoxication, vandalism, narcotics, and harassment during one week in November. Only one incident was reported to Radnor Police with 5 non-VU students who were trespassing. The other incidents were referred to "Disciplinary Review."
