Sara Pilling has met with a professional from Chanticleer Arboretum regarding advise on invasive plants and the correct plants and trees to use for replanting. Gina Bezdziecki suggested the Township website add a section for people who would be interested in donating trees in their loved one's name (like some of the trees around the Township Municipal Building.)

Peggy Gaskins suggested the we plant roses here at the Methodist Church. Sam Horsey of the Wayne Gardening Club and Gina will talk to Church representative for their input.

It was reported that the Spano Brothers Bar sign has been painted over since it was not a Township approved sign. Members wondered if the home recently purchased on Locust Grove Terrace would be turned into a Pa. State home as the company that purchased it has done with other properties throughout the Township
