The Bryn-Rose Civic Association met in the Radnor United Methodist Church, 930 Conestoga Road, Rosemont PA, at 7:00 pm on the above date.

Present

Minutes

Peggy Gaskins called the meeting to order. Sue Norcini motioned to approved the minutes of the February 28, 2008 meeting, seconded by Erma Calicyo, the motion was unanimously passed.

Treasurer's Report

Peggy Gaskins reported the that our grand total is \$569.64 to date. \$330. was turned over to the Garrett Hill Coalition since people wrote checks to the incorrect group and there is \$40.00 in petty cash.

New Business

Peggy Gaskins asked if police officers on patrol could report trash or other quality of life concerns to the proper township department. She asked if Bob Adams would contact Community Development for code enforcement on Glenbrook Avenue, walk the area to see the trash and filth, and take proper action. She also noted that the Lui's have acquired two more houses on County Line Road and are renting these to students, which is a violation due to the close proximity to existing student rentals. Sheets of lattice cover the view of the front porches. Erma Calicyo noted that porch furniture was recently stolen from a home. Roberta Winter noted that there were kids on the roofs of houses and police responded to both incidents. Gina Bezdieski reported that 139 Summit Terrace is coming up for sale and how could its status change? Sue Norcini reported that trash is being left all over the old Carpe Diem (now a caterer) on the corner of Conestoga Road and Summit Terrace, and full and broken beer bottles were left in the street.

Robert Winters noted that there will be a Land Use and Development 101 workshop at 7 p.m. on April 3rd at the township building. Patty Barker announced that the Garrett Hill zoning workshop will be held on April 15 at 7 p.m. at this church. Rick Barker explained the Master Plan had been edited and will be on the Web. Older uses will be "grandfathered", but set backs, lack of parking and density are still problems.

The Tuskegee Airmen presentation will be presented to April 23, 2008 at 7 p.m. at the Radnor Memorial Library on West Wayne Avenue.
